How to use Weathering Effects

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Diesel Stains

The stains of gasoline and diesel oil do not have the same color: Diesel Stains reproduces the exact orange shade of this fuel so that the streaks, traces and splashes caused by refueling with diesel in the field are perfectly reproduced.

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- 1 With the right information about the vehicle, we can know all about the engine and the logical area for placing stains or streaking traces of fuel. It is important to avoid symmetrical patterns in the location of spills or traces, since all these patterns are of a random nature.
- 2 For depicting these effects we can use a brush with rounded or flat tip or by airbrush.
- 3 The applied product reproduces the glossy and orange finish of the fuel.
- 4 Applied in various layers, the accumulated liquid shows a very real finish. Splash effects can be depicted by blowing air from an airbrush over a brush loaded with the product, and combining these with streaking effects.
