Liquid Mask

Liquid Mask 70.523 is very useful, not only to protect irregular-shaped areas during the painting process, which otherwise would be difficult to protect using masking tape, but also to reproduce the effects of worn paint and camouflage stains.

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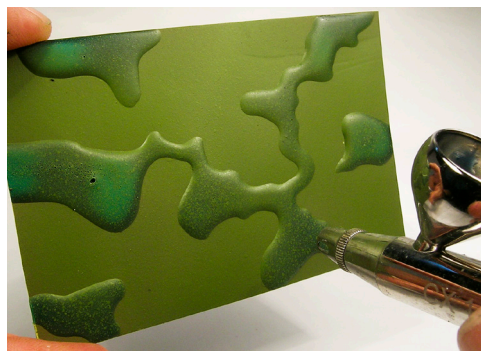
1 Irregular-shaped camouflage patches are applied to a surface already painted in its base color. Liquid Mask has a latex-based formulation.



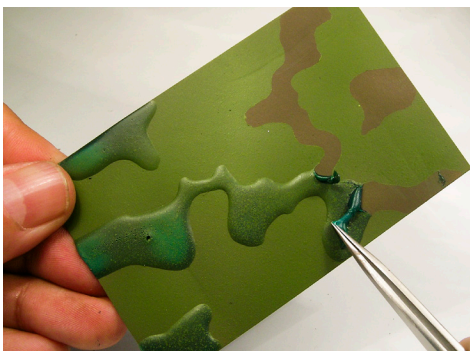
2 Several coats are applied by brush. Liquid Mask dries completely in about 30 minutes. Its texture is flexible, enabling it to conform to the most irregularly shaped surfaces.



3 Once the Liquid Mask is dry, a second shade is applied using Model Air.



4 Several thin coats are applied, taking care to avoid accumulations of paint.



5 After an hour, we can carefully remove the mask using tweezers and taking care not to damage the model's surface with their tip.



6 If necessary, some areas are touched up using the airbrush.



7 The result is a camouflage pattern with hard and well-defined edges.

Any brushes used to apply Liquid Mask must be cleaned with soap and water before it dries. Due to its formulation, Liquid Mask is very difficult to remove if it is allowed to dry completely on the brush fibers.
