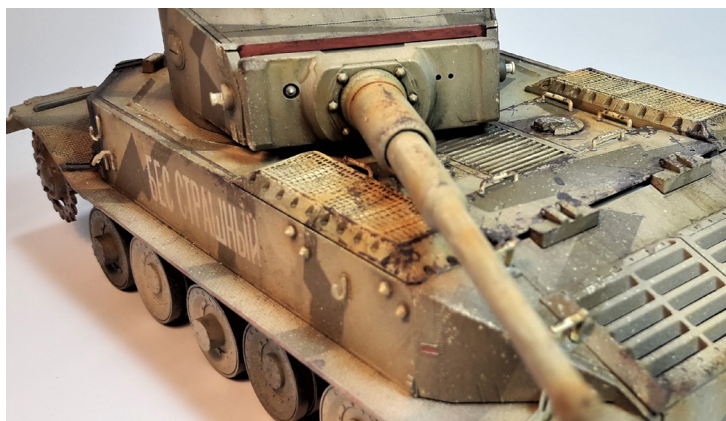

Metal Color on armored vehicles

The Metal Color range has multiple applications on armored vehicle models, as well as its many uses in aviation modeling. The painting of tracks is one of them, as we will see below.

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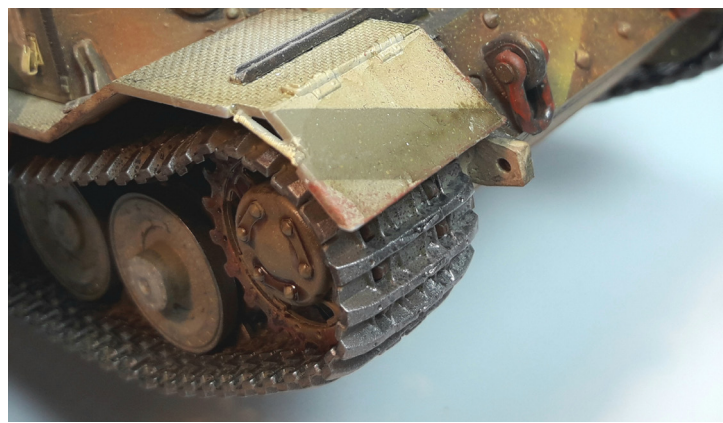
1 One of the biggest challenges facing the armored vehicle modeler is how to paint the vinyl tracks included in many kits.



2 The Metal Color range makes painting these tracks easy, due to its strong adhesive qualities and its durability. In this case, we will use Steel 77.712 and Silver 77.724.



3 Apply a base coat with Steel 77.712 using the airbrush with a pressure of 15 psi (approximately 1 kg).



4 Applying the color in several thin layers until the entire surface of the track is covered.



5 Then a layer of Silver 77.724 is applied using the dry brush technique on all the raised details of the tracks, replicating the polishing of the metal as it makes contact with the ground.



6 Successive applications of pigments on the bare metal, replicating the effects of dust or mud, help to achieve a very realistic result.
