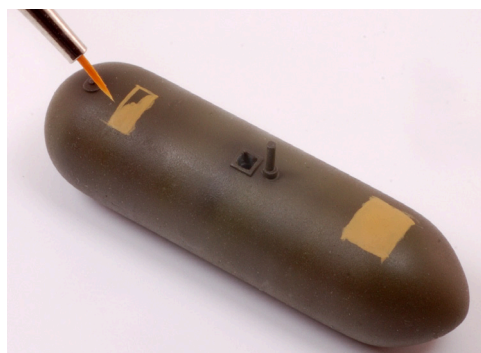

## Stencils

The constantly increasing complexity of the “Flying Machines” caused the need for a profusion of indications, warnings and basic procedures for their correct usage and maintenance. Below follows a method for the imitation and painting of a simple step by step procedure.

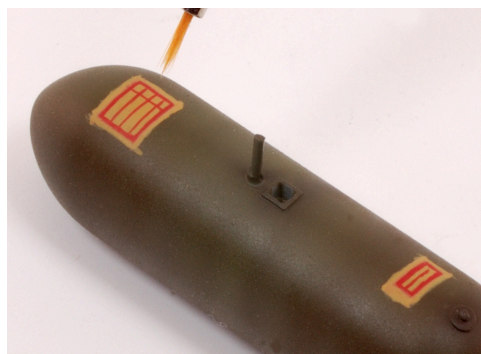
1 First the base is painted with the shape and outlines of the letters or stencils. There is no need to be too precise at this point.



2 Next, inside this area, the outlines of the text are drawn, or the lines that imitate the phrases or words.



3 Again, with the base color we correct the lines or outlines drawn, ensuring their correct width and length.



4 When the main outline is done, fine parallel lines are applied in the center to imitate the text.



5 This is the moment to cut and refine the base, and give it the primary color of the model.



6 If the image is to be applied without a frame, the same method is used, first the base color, then the outlines are drawn and next the symbols or letters.



7 For drawing an arrow, or an image, the vertical line is marked first and second the horizontal lines.



8 The outlines are filled in and given shape, generally longer and larger than they will be.



9 Finally, with the base color, the size and shape of the image will be corrected.
